ITINERARY

Day 1 Saturday, March 19, 2022 Depart Minneapolis

Depart Minneapolis/St. Paul to Honolulu, Hawai'i on scheduled air service. On arrival, experience the Aloha Spirit with a traditional fresh flower lei greeting. Transfer to your hotel in Waikiki for check-in. Walk to Queen Kapiolani Park for an Aloha pizza party with entertainment and hula lessons. **Inflight/D**

Day 2 Sunday, March 20, 2022 Honolulu

Breakfast will be on the hotel pool deck each morning. Take a guided walk through Waikiki to orient yourself to the area. Get lunch and then return to the hotel to change for your concert performance. Travel to Iolani High School or a local concert venue for an afternoon gala cultural exchange concert featuring instrumental, vocal and dance ensembles from both Iolani High School and Rosemount High School. Share the stage with fellow musicians in this collaborative concert which will be locally publicized within the community. Return to the hotel following the concert and enjoy a picnic dinner at Queen's Surf Beach. **B/D**

Day 3 Monday, March 21, 2022 Honolulu

Start your day by hiking about 3/4 of a mile to the 760-foot summit of the most recognized mountain in the world - Diamond Head Crater! Take photos of a fantastic 360-degree view of the southeast coast! Return to the hotel to change for an afternoon at the beach. Get lunch and walk to the beach. Rent a boogie board, take a surfing lesson or perhaps book a catamaran ride with friends. Tonight you have the evening free to get dinner in local Waikiki restaurants or International Market Place. **B**

Day 4 Tuesday, March 22, 2022 Pearl Harbor | Honolulu

Depart the hotel and transfer to Pearl Harbor's U.S.S. Arizona Memorial where you are met by the Rosemount HS Choir. Together you will perform a "Remember the Heroes" concert at Pearl Harbor in honor of the over 1000 servicemen that were entombed during the December 7, 1941 attack. A Fresh Flower Wreath Ceremony and Commemorative Award Presentation will follow the performance. Return to Waikiki with time to freshen up and change for the evening. Travel to the Nutridge Estate. The Estate, formerly the Hawai'i Macadamia Nut Company Ltd., was first macadamia nut plantation in the state. Enjoy a private interactive luau with members of the RHS Choir and Dance Program while dining on authentic Hawai'ian cuisine. **B/L/D**

Day 5 Wednesday, March 23, 2022 Honolulu

Begin your day with the Grand Alii Tour, a narrated drive across the Koolau Mountains to the tropical Windward side of O'ahu. You'll be met by your guide, a Polynesian Chief, who will share some of the customs and cultures of the native islanders. Board a raft to the secluded getaway, Secret Island. A day of "fun in the sun" on this private island includes volleyball, canoeing, kayaking, stand-up paddle board, badminton, sunbathing, and a delicious catered lunch. On the way back to Waikiki, make a visit to the Nuuanu Pali. In the evening head to the Ala Moana Center, the country's largest open-air mall. Enjoy dinner (on your own) at Makai Market with hundreds of food choices from around the world. **B/L**

Day 6 Thursday, March 24, 2022 Manoa | Honolulu

After breakfast board buses for the University of Hawaii. Have a morning workshop with Jeffrey Boeckman, Director of Bands. Take a tour of the campus and visit the bookstore for souvenirs. Return to Waikiki for a final afternoon on the beach or pursue other fun options with lunch on your own. Enjoy a festive final dinner at a local Waikiki restaurant. **B/D**

Day 7 Friday, March 25, 2022 Honolulu | Departure

Today is your last day in Hawaii. Have breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Board buses for a transfer to the Honolulu International Airport and depart on your transpacific flight back to the mainland. **B/Inflight**
